Proceeds from Come to the Table benefit The Peacemaker Program, Inc., a non-profit child advocacy and dispute resolution center, serving the central New York region.

There are a limited number of available tables due to space limitations and we expect a waiting list. Designers will be chosen on a first-come, first-serve basis.

Tables will be available for use during this event. You may provide your own or use one of our standard options:

- 54" round
- 60" round
- 72" x 30" rectangular
- 30" square
- Provide your own

The actual tables will not be auctioned unless designated by the designers. **All designers must seek approval if extra space is needed.**

You may solicit your own sponsor for your table entry or be the sponsor and designer yourself. Everything displayed on your table must be included in the purchase.

All sponsors and designers will be recognized at all Come to the Table events. You are welcome to leave your business cards as well as those of the sponsor on your table for further advertisement *after judging has ended.*

All donations are tax-deductible and a receipt will be provided to you.

Ideas on how to gain sponsorships for your table

- Be your own sponsor: use the event as a marketing opportunity for your business and receive a tax benefit as Peacemaker Program is a 501(c)(3) organization.
